The Little Falls Fire Department responded to a total of 711 alarms and Eagle Rescue Squad responded to a total of 1437 EMS calls for assistance. A total of 2148 emergency calls were handled through the Little Falls Fire Alarm dispatch in addition to the many non emergency business calls for the fire department. The increase of calls handled by the fire alarm dispatch center reaffirms the need to continue this vital service within our department.

During 2013 the Township of Little Falls experienced Two (2) minor working fires:

103 Main Street	Structure Fire	May 13, 2013

On January 30, 2013, The Township of Little Falls experienced a major incident involving a N.J. Transit train. Emergency Personnel from multiple agencies were involved and worked diligently in completing the task that particular morning.

As Chief of The Department I was extremely proud and honored to be working with our officers and membership, along with all mutual aid responders from Fire, EMS and Police agencies at this emergency. This large scale incident exemplified the importance of (ICS) Incident Command System.

Department line officers held monthly meetings throughout the year to discuss operations, policies and future development within the department. The Board of Fire Officers held meetings to discuss personnel issues, review and document General Orders and Standard Operating Procedures within our Department, with the first phase of General Orders 14-1 to 14-29 to be implemented on January 1, 2014.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS 2014

- Obtain final approval for bond ordinance for the replacement of Engine #2, \$675,000.
- Engine 4 is due for replacement as it has completed 22 years of service. Substantial savings can be obtained by combining replacement of Engine 2 and Engine 4 at the same time.
- Secure funding for the replacement of two (2) Township Ambulance units 842 & 843, \$296,000.
- LOSAP contribution is being requested to increase from 1250.00 to \$1350.00 for qualifying members. This contribution has not been increased since 2008.
- Requested to implement an EMS LOSAP Contribution for the members of Eagle Hose Co #1 and members of the Little Falls Fire dept who volunteer EMS services. (\$1200.00, for a qualifying member). The Board of Fire Officers to prepare proposed ordinance for this request.
- Increase the yearly clothing allowance to \$350.00 for qualifying members for 2014.
- Replacement of 100 Motorola Minitor IV pagers needed by the Fire Dept. The current pagers are often inoperable and/or failing when a call is dispatched. Replacement parts for the current fleet of pagers are no longer available. Estimated cost for replacement \$57,500 under state contract pricing.
- Air-packs (SCBA) will need to be replaced by year end 2015. The total cost is estimated at \$150K per year over a three year period. Total cost estimated of \$450K. It has been recommended to begin accrual for this replacement in 2013.
- The LFFD dispatch needs to purchase and install a C.A.D system as current operations are substandard due to the lack of this technology. The estimated price for this project is \$21,000.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS 2012/2013

- Engine, Ladder Truck and Rescue training was conducted on Company and Department levels to enhance effective and safe fire ground procedures. Department drills also included the utilization of instructors from outside the department
- Successful completion of the Firefighter One Course offered at Passaic County Public Safety Academy by eight (8) of our members.
- Continued to work with New Jersey American Water Company for upgrading water supply throughout the Township of Little Falls.
- The RAPID ENTRY SYSTEM, (Knox Box) program has continued to expand on a commercial and residential level. We have increased our participation in this program. This program is a vital role in rapid entry and ensuring the safety for both our firefighters and the residents of the Township of Little Falls.
- As part of Operation Graduation; a joint demonstration with The Little Falls Police and Fire Departments along with the NJ State Police North Star, Medi-Vac helicopter was held on Hopson Avenue for Passaic Valley High School senior students. The demonstration consisted of a reenactment of a severe traffic accident as a result of drunk driving. The students observed the exercise and were reminded of the dangers of drinking and driving.
- Continued to work with Piercon Solutions to address the radio communications system and recommend improvements. This includes portable, mobile and base stations located at the various fire companies. Upon completion of the project the equipment will be reprogrammed and assigned accordingly. Throughout this past year weekly meetings and conference calls have been held along with onsite reviews to assist in this process. The overall goal is to implement an effective radio system for Fire/EMS and Police. This project with Piercon Solutions has been ongoing since Dec 17, 2011.
- Continued to work closely with the Fire Official, Fire Inspectors and Building Inspector to insure code enforcement for the safety and well being of our residents and firefighters. The new addition of Thomas Fahy and Leo Loder in the Fire Prevention Bureau has complimented our bureau.

- Continue working with our Mayor, Business Administrator and Town Council members on matters pertaining to the Fire Department budget, expenditures and capital improvements.
- Continue to work closely with the Fire Official, Fire Inspectors and Building Inspector to insure code enforcement for the safety and well being of our residents and firefighters.
- A committee has been formed to review and propose revisions of the By-Laws of The Little Falls Fire Department.





THIS DOCUMENT CONSTITUTES THE REPORT OF ACTIVITIES OF THE EAGLE RESCUE SQUAD RELATED TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE PROVIDED DURING THE 2013 FIRE YEAR

1. Summary of Ambulance Services

A total of 1437 requests were made during the 2013 fire year. We started the 2013 fire year off with incidents relating to Hurricane Sandy. As part of the New Jersey EMS Task Force, Eagle Rescue Squad took part in the largest deployment of Emergency Medical resources to date. Our crews worked tirelessly to provide quality care to those who needed it during some of the worst and most hazardous weather conditions that New Jersey has ever seen.

Over the course of the year our company responded to a wide variety of emergencies. These emergencies included motor vehicle accidents, boating incidents, a mass casualty response involving a tractor trailer vs. NJ Transit train, traumas, along with many other medical emergencies. Even with calls that occurred in town, Eagle Rescue Squad also supported other neighboring EMS agencies with mutual aid coverage, standbys at various fires, as well as other NJ EMS Task Force requests. On top of all of those emergencies, Eagle Rescue Squad also provided EMS coverage for Passaic Valley High School's home football games. Working in conjunction with PV's athletic director, as well as the West Paterson and Totowa First Aid Squads, all of Passaic Valley's home games were covered. At the request of the recreation department, Company 1 also provided coverage for the Jr Hornet Football games at the Recreation Center. Eagle Rescue Squad also covered Montclair State University with their EMS program for special events throughout the campus. Lastly, Eagle Rescue

Squad with the fire department provided a DWI/auto extrication demo to promote awareness of the dangers of drinking and driving to the students at Passaic Valley High School.

2. Equipment Acquisition

We placed two carbon monoxide monitors in service to protect our EMS crews from potentially hazardous environments. The monitors are located on each medical bag and are utilized on every call.

3. Training

Our members continue to maintain their EMT and CPR certifications as per the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services. Eagle Rescue Squad has held EMS, fire, rescue, and boat drills on a monthly basis throughout the year to maintain our skills and proficiency. Many of our members have attended outside classes as well to obtain Continuing Education Units and further their education.

4. Recommendations

I am recommending that Eagle Rescue Squad continue to find new ways to recruit and retain new members, especially residents from within the Township of Little Falls. I am encouraging other members from within the Fire Department to consider assisting the Rescue Squad by becoming drivers for the ambulance or consider obtaining their EMT certification. Our ambulances are now six years old. The Township should begin to look into replacing the ambulances; this will limit the cost of repairs and down time for aging equipment.

5. Acknowledgements

The members of Eagle Rescue Squad/Eagle Hose Company 1 wish to extend their thanks and sincere appreciation to other members of the Little Falls Fire Department as well as members of the Little Falls Police Department for their assistance throughout the fire year. It is a privilege to work alongside each and every one of you. I would also like to thank our dispatchers. Little Falls is very fortunate to have a fire department dispatch center. It is the men and women monitoring the radios and coordinating our assignments that helps keep us safe every time we leave the firehouse. To the residents of Little Falls along with the Mayor and Council, thank you for all of your continued support of Eagle Rescue Squad/Eagle Hose Company 1.



Dear Chief Sweezy,

Please accept the following as the 2013 yearend report for the Township of Little Falls Municipal Fire Alarm System.

Various fire alarm system maintenance tasks were performed throughout the year. These tasks included repainting and refurbishing street boxes, transferring our lines to all of the new poles Public Service has placed throughout the town, and performing regular voltage monitoring of all three circuits.

The Fire Alarm crew has also surveyed and planned two projects for new line. Currently the only single conductor line wire that is still in service is on Long Hill Road south / east of Ridge Road. This would require approximately 3,000 feet of new wire to replace. The second project is to have box 62 – Cedar Grove Road at Charles Street put back in service. This would require 1,000 feet of new wire.

This year on two separate occasions, either lightning or public utility electricity surged our system. Each surge was handled properly by the fuses and lightning arresters installed throughout the system. The fuses and lightning arresters were replaced shortly after each event. I am very proud to report that Little Falls Municipal Fire Alarm system was fully operational 365 days of the 2013 fire year.
