-\$42.00 PERMIT FEE- ASSEMBLY PERFORMANCES

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

1. Fee for a Type I permit shall be \$42.00 for a one time occurrence as stated in N.J.A.C. 5:70-2.7 (a). An annual permit is available for \$84.00. All entertainment performances must be first approved by the Code Official. Proper insurance coverage must be submitted with the permit application.
2. If performing under a tent and/or tarp, the tent and/or tarp must be of a flame resistive material or spray (certification of flame resistance must be available upon request of Fire Inspector) as stated in the New Jersey Uniform Fire Code. All indoor performances must first be approved by the Code Official.
3. All performances involving fire must not be used within twenty-five feet (25') of combustible materials or any structures.
4. A portable fire extinguisher must be present at all times. The fire extinguisher must be in good condition and have current documentation of annual service. It must be of a minimum 3A-40BC or larger rating (5lb. or larger). The extinguisher shall be easily accessible and located not more than 15 feet and not less than 10 feet from the hazard. A bucket of water must be within the same distances as the fire extinguisher to snuff out the fire when the performance is finished.
5. The Fire Official shall be notified at least 10 days prior to the any public event in writing, with application and fee (if not a yearly permit), for the permit of all events in which entertainment will take place.

These guidelines have been set to ensure the safety of you and the public. If they are not met, you may be subject to penalties and/or immediate stoppage of the performance
