-\$42.00 PERMIT FEE- ASSEMBLY / EDUCATION USES

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

When places of assembly or education are used by outside agencies or organizations, the following sections of the NJ State Fire Code shall apply:

1. No person or organization shall permit overcrowding beyond the established occupancy for that room.
2. The Fire Official shall approve all decorative material.
3. Candles or open flames are NOT permitted to be used unless prior approval by the Fire Official is granted!
4. Ten minutes before any performance or activity, an announcement shall be made, pointing out the locations of all exits and smoking regulations. This is a requirement of the New Jersey State Uniform Fire Code, and this must be stated as part of the announcement.
5. There shall be no blocking or obstruction of exit doors, aisles or stairways with chairs, tables, or decorative materials. Seating or tables will not be permitted in aisles or hallway areas.
6. All exit signs shall be illuminated at all times.
7. There shall be ***no parking*** of vehicles in front of the building and in any area designated with markings as a fire lane. Vehicles parked in these areas will be ticketed.
8. In the event of an activated fire alarm, ***all*** occupants shall immediately ***evacuate*** the building in an orderly manner. Under no circumstance is anyone to remain in the building unless authorized to do so by the fire department.
